


# Crosstown Trails - West Dover, Vt.

-  Graded trail
  -  Gravel roadbed or woods road
  -  Footpath/singletrack trail
  -  Roads
  -  Buildings
  -  Power line
  -  20-foot contours elevations in feet
  -  Wetlands
- For mountain biking, singletrack trails are mostly of intermediate difficulty.

**Parking:** on Handle Rd  
 - 1.0 mi. south of Tannery Rd  
 - 3.7 mi. north of Rte. 100

1.0 mi. to Rte. 100

**Some trail distances:**  
 Crosstown Trail: 1.05 mi.  
 Valley Trail: 0.6 mi.  
 Sherwood Forest: 2.1 mi.  
 Little John Trail: 1.5 mi.

**Do the loop:**  
 From parking lot to Friar Tuck, Sherwood Forest, Little John, Airport Rd, and back on Crosstown Trail: 5.35 mi.
